Students who enrol in this course must be employed in the Forest Industry. You could complete the full Certificate II in Harvesting and Haulage within one (1) year. Depending on you and your employers needs, learning may be held at your worksite, at a TSI campus in Clarence, Alanvale or Burnie, or at an agreed destination.

Course Results and Skills Gained: After completing the course, you may undertake Certificate III in Harvesting and Haulage, or become a qualified Leading Hand or Bush Boss.

What resources will I need?

Students will need to supply the following:

- Steel capped safety boots (lace up)
- High visibility outer garment
- Full face safety helmet with hearing protection
- Cut resistant leg protection

The Skills Institute will supply some equipment associated with commercial chainsaw courses.
