## Certificate II in Horticulture

### RTF 20103



This course is for people who are currently employed in a horticultural workplace, and have a Training Contract. You could complete the full Certificate II in Horticulture within fifteen (15) months on the job. Depending on you and your employers needs, learning may be on-the-job, off-the-job or a combination of both. Learning may be held at your workplace, at a TSI campus in Clarence, Alanvale or Burnie.

**Course Results and Skills Gained:** After completing the course, you may undertake Certificate III in Horticulture, or become a qualified Horticultural worker. Areas of work can include Nursery, Turf, Landscaping, Arboriculture, Parks & Gardens, or Controlled Environment- including Hydroponics.

**Course Includes:** A total of 17 units of competency must be completed (4 core units and 13 elective units). See below for a common selection of elective units, taken from over 100 available units of competence.
