Students who enrol in this course must be employed in the Forest Industry. You could complete the full Certificate III in Forest Growing and Management within two (2) years. Depending on you and your employers needs, learning may be held at your worksite, at a TSI campus in Clarence, Alanvale or Burnie, or at a selected forestry coupe.

Course Results and Skills Gained: After completing the course, you may undertake further study in Certificate III in Harvesting and Haulage, or become a qualified Leading Hand or Crew Leader.

- High visibility outer garment
- Full face safety helmet with hearing protection
- Cut resistant leg protection
