

## **Furthering Your Forestry Career** Certificate III in Harvesting and Haulage FPI 30205



This course is for people who are currently employed in the Forest industry, possibly as Apprentices or Trainees. You could complete the full Certificate III in Harvesting and Haulage within two (2) years. Depending on your needs, learning may be on-the-job, off-the-job or a combination of both.

Course Requirements: Pre-requisites apply. Please contact us for more information.

**Course Results and Skills Gained:** After completing the course, you may proceed to Certificate IV in Forest Operations or Certificate III in Forest Growing and Management, or become a qualified Leading Hand or Crew Leader.

## What resources will I need?

Students will need to supply the following:

- Steel capped safety boots (lace up)
- High visibility outer garment
- Full face safety helmet with hearing protection
- Cut resistant leg protection

The Skills Institute will supply some equipment associated with commercial chainsaw courses.
