Students who enrol in this course must be employed in a Horticultural workplace. You could complete the full Certificate III in Horticulture within two (2) years. Depending on you and your employers needs, learning may be held at your workplace, at a TSI campus in Clarence, Alanvale or Burnie, or at an agreed destination.

Course Results and Skills Gained: After completing the course, you may undertake Certificate IV in Horticulture, or become a qualified Horticultural tradesperson. Areas of work can include Nursery, Turf, Landscaping, Arboriculture, Parks & Gardens, or Controlled Environment- including Hydroponics.
