Safety & Compliance

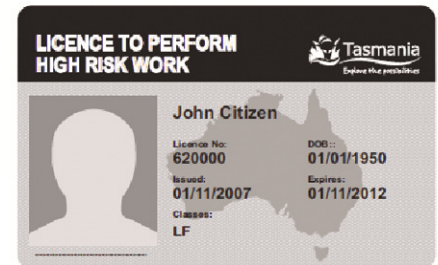
National OHS regulations require anyone engaged in work outlined below to have a National High Risk Work Licence.

Only registered assessors with Workplace Standards or equivalent interstate authorities are permitted to carry out assessment.

Licences must be renewed every five (5) years.
