This course is for people who are currently working in the Rural Industry and wish to gain a qualification. You could complete the full Diploma of Agriculture within two (2) years. Depending on you and your employers needs, learning may be on-the-job, off-the-job or a combination of both.

Course Requirements: Certificate IV in Agriculture or able to demonstrate competence at that level.

Course Results and Skills Gained: After completing the course, you may proceed to an Advanced Diploma of Agriculture.
