

# Fast Track Your Qualification



Do you work in the horticulture, agriculture, forestry or conservation and land management industries? If you do, did you know that you can fast track your qualifications by attending a series of one day workshops?

This program is designed to provide 8 - 10 of the units required towards either a Certificate IV or Diploma level qualification, specific to your industry. By attending the workshops you will receive training in each unit, hear from industry guest speakers as well as receiving an outline of the project requirements for each unit you have chosen. These projects will be able to be adopted to suit your specific workplace or situation.

### Who Should Do This Course?

**Certificate IV** - anyone who has recently finished a Certificate III and is seeking extra skills and knowledge, or people that are currently working in the industry as supervisors or leading hands. **Diploma**— anyone who has recently completed a Certificate IV or manages/owns a business.

#### **Course Content**

Broken up into 5, 1 day workshops. You can attend all the workshops or just the ones that are appropriate to your circumstances. Each workshop will cover revision of subject, guest speakers and project explanation.

**Workshop 1** – OH&S and machinery

Workshop 2 - Costing projects and managing staff

Workshop 3 - Soils and irrigation

**Workshop 4** – Plant health, weeds, pests and diseases.

Workshop 5 – Business planning.

Participants will receive relevant course material.

#### **Outcome**

By attending as many of the workshops as possible you will work towards a full qualification. Certificate IV in Horticulture, Agriculture and Conservation and Land Management requires 12 units and 10 units for a Diploma. Certificate IV in Forestry requires 14 units and 16 units for a Diploma.
