

Licensed Skills Forklift Operations



This two day course will provide participants with the underpinning knowledge and skills to achieve a national licence for the safe operation of a forklift truck.

Course requirements: Participants must be 18 years of age or over for Worksafe Australia accreditation.

PPE requirements: Appropriate clothing and footwear.

Participants will learn how to perform:

- Pre-operation checks.
- Planning the work.
- Checking controls on equipment.
- Shifting and stacking load.
- Loading and unloading.
- Shutting down equipment.
- Securing the site.

Core Unit: Operate a Forklift TLIDI007C

Outcome: Statement of Attainment. Participants are then able to apply for a Workplace Standards Certificate of Competency to Operate a Forklift Truck – Class L.F. at an additional cost of \$55 which can be paid at any Service Tasmania office.

If you already have experience in operating a forklift but do not have a current licence, arrangements can be made for 'assessment only'. Assessments will be co-ordinated over the two days on enrolment.
