

# Licence and Competency Card Categories

## Safety & Compliance

### Work Safely in the Construction Industry (CPCCOHS1001A)

The *National Code of Practice for Induction for Construction Work* requires that **all construction workers** undertake training to receive the new national 'White Card'. White Card training includes OHS, emergency procedures, risk management and construction hazards. A nationally recognised Competency Card and Statement of Attainment will be issued upon successful completion. There is no expiry date.

### Skills Institute Competency Cards

Competency Cards are issued for nationally recognised courses that result in a Statement of Attainment. Examples include but are not limited to: Encapsulate & Remove Asbestos, Control Traffic, Confined Spaces, First Aid, Machinery (Civil), Working at Heights, ATV and Four Wheel Drive training. (Note: High Risk Licences are not part of this category.)

### Tasmanian Industry and Mining Induction (TIMI)

TIMI is an online induction and assessment program for the mining sector. Participants can undertake 'generic', 'underground' or 'site specific' induction assessments. This program includes the occupational health and safety requirements applicable to all work areas including surface work, underground, production and processing areas.

### ForestWorks Operator Licence (Previously TFITB Operator Licence)

This licence is compulsory for those working in the forest industry (such as chainsaw, faller or machinery operators). There is a primary focus on safety and the environment. Councils, TFGA and Parks & Wildlife also use this licensing system. Licences must be renewed every 3 years. Contact ForestWorks Licensing on (03) 6331 6077.

### ChemCert

ChemCert is a nationally recognised course in chemical safety and handling for those using agricultural and veterinary chemicals. Participants will prepare and apply chemicals under close supervision and learn how to transport, handle and store chemicals. Certificates are to be renewed every 5 years.
