Become a multi-skilled operator or specialise in a limited range of skills that specifically relate to either tourism operations or marketing coordination.

Individuals with this qualification are able to work in any sector of the tourism industry as senior personnel or supervisors. Tourism industry senior personnel will often specialise in certain fields; most often in operational functions or marketing roles. In the retail travel sector personnel often specialise in corporate or leisure travel.
